Developer of an evidence-based mental health treatment for young children exposed to domestic violence and other traumatic

life events, Dr. Lieberman has advanced our understanding of attachments, toddler development and the effects of domestic violence on children and families.

A social worker and expert in mental health, Dr. Brave Heart is best known for her efforts to understand mental health and substance abuse

in indigenous populations and to intervene to help indigenous populations heal from historical trauma.
