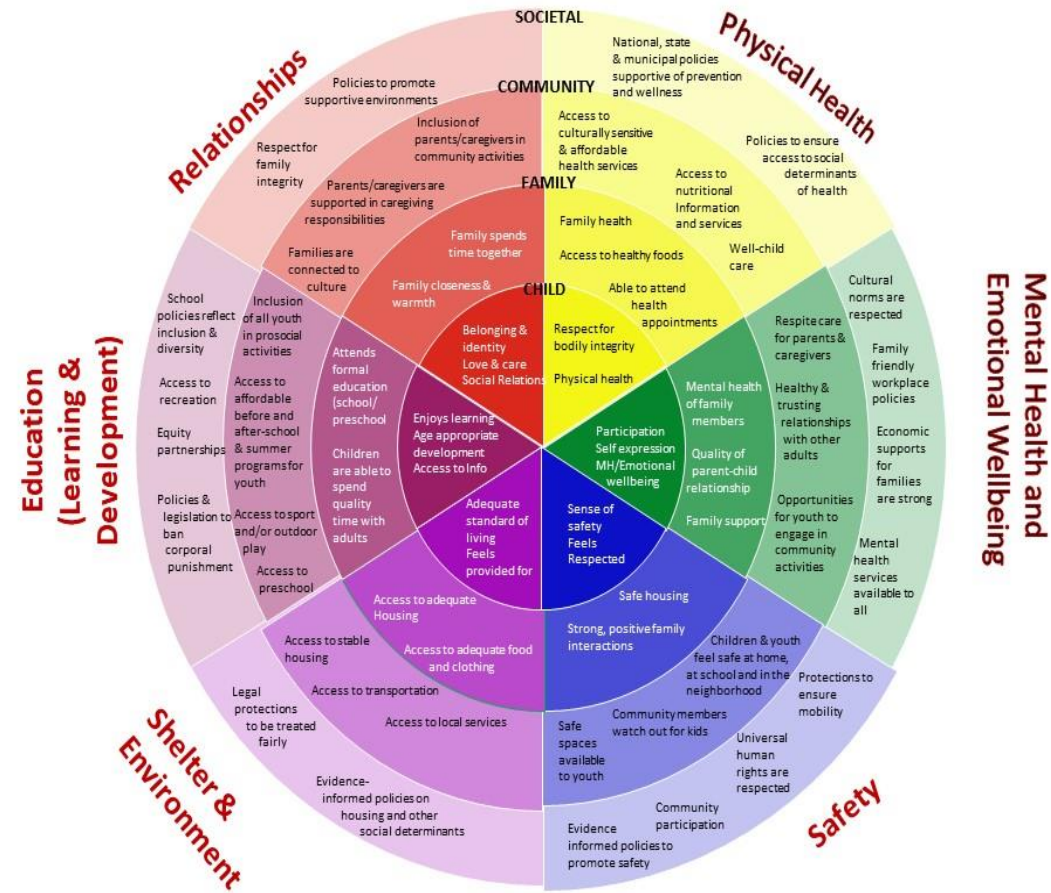

Primary Prevention Framework for Child Trafficking

Strategies for Implementing the Framework

- ▶ Respect and support relationships that are important to children
- ▶ Ensure opportunities for children and youth to actively participate, including in decision making of community structures
- ▶ Principles of universality and inclusiveness guide opportunities
- ▶ Strategies are child-centered, and family-focused
- ▶ Community investment in children and youth promote family functioning
- ▶ Strategies are comprehensive
- ▶ Strategies are tailored to community strengths and resources
